

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PERSOANL CELL PHONE /ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students are to have their cell phones and all other electronic devices turned off and put away during class instructional time. We allow cell phones before and after school, during lunch, and between classes as long as it is not disruptive to the learning environment and does not pose a safety risk.

DROPPING ITEMS OFF FOR STUDENTS

If you need to drop something off for your student, please know that we do not interrupt classes. We are happy to hold items that students can pick up before or after school, lunch times, or in between class periods. Have your student stop by the Main Office if they have forgotten an item.



AUTOMATED PHONE MESSAGES

South High communicates important information to parents using our automated dialer system. The system will attempt to reach you up to three times. If you hang up before the message is finished the system reads this as an incomplete call and will dial your number again. Please stay on the line to receive the complete message.

STUDENTS IN THE BUILDING AFTER SCHOOL

We are unable to supervise students after school hours. Unless your student is involved in a staff-supervised, after-school activity in the building, they will be asked to leave by 3:30 p.m. If students are waiting for a ride, they are encouraged to wait outside the building. Please plan for transportation to arrive prior to 3:30pm whenever possible.

PARENTVUE/STUDENTVUE

A parent's involvement in their child's education is one of the most crucial factors in school success and achievement. ParentVUE and StudentVUE are convenient and secure ways for parents and students to access essential information on grades, attendance, scores on individual assignments, and links to teacher emails to aide in communication. Simply click on a course title for assignments, or the teacher's name for email.

One account will connect each parent with all of their students in Salem-Keizer Schools. Usernames and passwords are carried over each year. If you do not have an account, please contact the main office.

CHECKING IN/OUT

If your student needs to leave school early for an appointment, please send a note that they can take to the Attendance Office that morning. Students receive a pass to leave class at the appropriate time, cutting down on classroom interruptions.

If you do not send a note with your student, you will need to come into the building with photo I.D. to check them out. For security reasons, we do not check students out via the telephone. All students arriving late must check in at the attendance window before going to class. If your student arrives to school after 8:30am, please write them a note to excuse the tardy. If your student is out ill and you leave a message on the Attendance line, please speak clearly, spell the last name of your student and give the student ID number. Include the date you want excused and the reason for the absence. You can also send a note with them when they return to school.

Please DO NOT leave a message on the automated line for your student to check out. The messages are only checked once in the morning and once after school.

NO CHECKING OUT AFTER 3:10 PM

Students will not be allowed to check out after 3:10 pm. unless you send a note with your student earlier in the day. The school day ends at 3:20 pm.
