

IB Exam Registration

Who is Eligible to take an IB exam?

Any student in the 12th grade who sat for both years of a two-year HL (Higher Level) or SL (Standard Level) course may test. In addition, juniors and seniors in a one- year SL course may test.

Cost?

\$102 (free with financial need- if student applies); Payment is due Monday October 17th

When are exams?

No alternative testing dates are provided and no refunds will be given. Therefore it is important for families to recognize the potential conflicts with OSAA activities scheduled in May, the same testing month as IB exams. Completing the conflicts exam survey will highlight potential conflicts. Please complete the conflict survey <u>HERE</u>.



SAXON ATHLETICS

To register for a winter sport, students will need to go to Family ID to complete the Saxon Athletic Registration. <u>Family ID</u> registration for winter sports will be open **Wednesday, October 25th - Wednesday, November 2nd**.

All students must have a current physical within the last 2 years on file with the school. Sports physicals have to be submitted on the OSAA physical form, available in the vestibule to the Main Office, or online at OSAA.org.


To check if your student has a current sports physical on file, please call 503-399-3252 and ask for Mrs. Bosco in the Athletic Office.






